ARTICLE I. OBLIGATION TO UNITED CHURCH OF CHRIST

SECTION A. WIDER CHURCH

The Congregation shall regularly contribute toward the work and mission of the United Church of Christ, the South Central ~~Conference~~, and the Brazos Association.

SECTION C. SPECIAL ~~CONGREGATIONAL~~ MEETINGS

A Special meeting of the Congregation may be called at any time by the Steering Ministry or by ten (10) members of the Congregation by petition to the Moderator. The meeting will be held within ~~three weeks~~ of the presentation of the petition to the Moderator. No other business will be transacted except that for which the meeting was called.

SECTION D. VOTING PRIVILEGE

Members of the Church present at a meeting will be entitled to vote. Absentee balloting may be available at the discretion of the Steering Ministry.

SECTION E. OPEN MEETINGS

Any Church member may attend any Church meeting (excluding Pastoral Relations, ~~and in discussions of personnel issues~~) in a non-voting capacity and may participate in any and all discussions.

ARTICLE III. ELECTIONS

ARTICLE B. TERM OF OFFICE

The term of office for all elected officers will be two (2) years and will begin on July 1 following their election, excepting Youth Representatives who serve for one (1) year terms. No person will be elected to any one position for more than two (2) consecutive years.

ARTICLE C. LIMITATIONS OF SERVICE

No member of the Church will hold more than one elected position at a time, with the exception of members of the Pastoral Relations Ministry Team.

ARTICLE IV. NOMINATING COMMITTEE

ARTICLE A. PURPOSE

The purpose of this committee is to present a slate of candidates to the church membership at a Congregational Meeting.

ARTICLE B. MEMBERSHIP

Nominating Committee will consist of the out-going Congregational Representative, who convenes and chairs the Nominating Committee, and two other members appointed by the Steering Ministry (who are not currently on Steering), and the Pastor as an ex-officio member.

ARTICLE V. STEERING MINISTRY

SECTION A. QUORUM

A quorum will consist of five (5) VOTING members.

SECTION B. CREATION OF AD HOC GROUPS

The Steering Ministry will have the authority to create any ad-hoc group for the purpose of examining special issues of concern and taking action in accordance.

7. The Congregational Representatives will serve as a voice for members of the Congregation for all deliberations of the Steering Ministry. The Congregational Representative whose term is ending that year, will convene and chair the Nominating Committee.

#### ARTICLE VIII. OTHER PROGRAMS OF THE CHURCH

##### SECTION A. RELATIONSHIPS TO THE CHURCH

The Church may enter into relationships with ~~outside~~ programs or organizations. These organizations are fiscally accountable through Steering. They will have on file a Statement of Purpose and will report at least annually to Steering. They cannot encumber debt in the name of Friends ~~Congregational~~ Church. #### ARTICLE IX. PASTORAL RELATIONS MINISTRY

##### SECTION A. COMPOSITION AND TERM OF OFFICE

The Pastoral Relations Ministry will consist of four members. Two will be appointed by Steering and two elected by the Congregation. The term of office is two (2) years with one appointed and one elected member taking office each year. Meetings are closed due to the sensitive nature of information discussed.

##### SECTION B. DUTIES

The Pastoral Relations Ministry team will serve as an advocate of the ministry and as a confidant of the Pastor so as to anticipate and resolve problems that might arise as well as work with the Pastor to permit that individual to grow and mature with the Congregation. Finally, the ministry team will seek to work with the Pastor in helping that person develop goals for the pastoral ministry and growth and development of the Church.

SECTION C. ANNUAL EVALUATION OF PASTOR

The Pastoral Relations Ministry team will evaluate the Pastor annually-- celebrating successes and setting goals for the coming year. ARTICLE X. PASTOR

SECTION A. VACANCY

When a vacancy occurs in the Pastorate, the Steering Ministry will appoint a Search Committee of seven (7) persons from the Church membership and will, with the cooperation of the South Central Conference, United Church of Christ, recommend to the church a suitable candidate for the position.

SECTION B. TERMINATION

The termination of Pastoral duties may be effected by Congregational vote or by the Pastor upon ninety (90) days written notice. The requirement of the ninety days may be waived by mutual consent of the Pastor and the Steering Ministry.
